Parent-Teacher interviews (held by phone or email instead of in-person) will be October 28<sup>th</sup>, 4-7pm. Have your parent sign up using <u>http://swc.schoolappointments.com/</u> which can be found on the SWC website. Interviews will be 5 minutes in length to accommodate as many families as possible. Also, teachers have established daily office hours that they can be reached to further answer student questions. Look to the school website for more information.

- Telephone call with a Blocked Caller ID
- Email inviting the parents to a virtual meeting through Outlook or Meet (if declined, an alternate method will be offered)
