Definitions You Should Know!

Scholarship: a financial award made to support a student's education, based on academic or other achievements. Scholarships are **EARNED**

Bursary: is a financial award granted to a student on the basis of the student's **FINANCIAL NEED**

Award: a prize or other mark of a recognition given in honour of high academics or an achievement.

Bursaries and grants are based primarily on an individual's financial needs, but may involve other selection criteria such as extracurricular activities, community involvement and leadership. Financial Aid

Grant: free money, you do not pay it back

Loan: you must pay it back (usually with interest) after graduation

Schools located in smaller areas tend to cost less than schools in BIG cities





Things to Consider for OSAP



OSAP tends to give more money if you travel farther away for school

The "OSAP Estimator" will help you plan how much you <u>might</u> receive but you will not be given an actual amount until you have paid for an acceptance to a post-secondary institution





What is Usually Needed to Apply for a Scholarship

Bursaries will need proof of Financial Need

- Transcript or Graduation Summary
- Awards
- Extra-Curricular and Volunteer Involvement (above the required amount)
- Leadership Opportunities
- Employment History
- Reference Letters
- Sometimes an essay or personal statement is asked for
- Accomplishments in any other areas



Reference Letters

Ask EARLY: give two weeks notice

Ask a trusted and responsible adult who knows you well: Teacher, Coach, Employer, Principal (not a relative)

Provide them with:

- A Resume
- List of activities/clubs
- Details about the audience
- Your academic/program goals
- Letter of Reference Request Form



Nomination Process

Some Scholarships/Bursaries require the school to nominate a candidate(s)- these are called Sponsored Applications ex. Schulich Scholarship.

Students who wish to be considered for a school sponsorship forward an SWC application to Ms.Davis-Thompson. She then coordinates the staff selection process, and works with the sponsored candidate to complete the scholarship.

BE AGGRESSIVE BULLDOGS!!!





START EARLY: some close in the fall Research: create a database **Review DEADLINES** and process information Read Criteria, only apply for those that you qualify for Neatness and clarity are ESSENTIAL Quality rather than quantity Keep a hard copy and backup copy for all applications Ask for TIPS from previous winners Don't forget SWC SPRING Scholarship, Awards and **Bursaries**

Complete and submit a "Please Consider Me (Nomination) Form" in the spring

Read the Criteria Carefully

Every year there are some scholarships/awards/bursaries that require the SWC Awards Committee to submit a nominee from our school. Some awards are guaranteed to go to an SWC grad, while others are even more competitive with only one student from DSBN being selected as the recipient.

Every year there are also some SWC-specific scholarship/awards/bursaries that require the SWC Awards Committee to select a recipient from a group of nominees.

Student names are brought to the attention of the SWC Awards committee by SWC staff members. As well, in some cases, students may submit their names for consideration. While it is rare for students to submit a self-nomination form, and not already be a nominee, this form will serve to reassure a student that their name has indeed been brought forward at the SWC Awards Committee table.

The SWC Awards Committee is comprised of teacher representation from all departments. Every decision is vetted, and approved, by SWC Administration.

This form is to be completed, and submitted, by Potential Grads, Class of June 2020, ONLY. Submit one form per scholarship/award/bursary AND ensure that it is one that accepts self-nominations!
