### **CAREER CRUISING – COMPLETION OF Gr. 12 IPP REQUIREMENTS**

**Grade 10** = Career Matchmaker, My Saved Careers (3), Build my Resume...DONE!


**Grade 11** = My Saved Programs (3)...DONE!

Be sure that all of these previous grade activities have been completed before continuing on.

#### NOW...Complete the following IPP activities:

- My Saved Schools Under My Education; find and save 3 schools which offer programs of interest.
- Career and Life Goals Under My Goals and Plans; enter 1 short term and 1 long term goal. These activities will move the Progress Bar on your IPP to 100% completion <u>in September when</u>

# **FURTHER POST-SECONDARY RESEARCH**

Now is the time to ensure that you have the pre-requisites for your post-secondary program on your Course Plan for Gr. 12. If you are college-bound, check with your college to see if you need to have ENG4C1 (or any other pre-requisite course) completed in S1. <u>Some college programs</u> require final grades, especially for competitive programs, before giving out an offer in February. If your program is competitive, and you do not have final grades, your program will likely fill up before you are eligible to be considered.

## \*ontransfer.ca (College/University Overlaps and Connections)

Enter as a High School Student.

Under "Plan to earn a diploma and degree" click on "Program Transfer Guide". Select "all colleges and all universities", then select a field of study and type in a key word. Scroll and compare the pathway options for that field of study from college to university. Repeat these steps but this time, select "collaborative and joint degree programs".

#### PG INTERVIEW GOOGLE DOC

Every Potential Grad will complete their IPP requirements (in Career Cruising) AND their Grad Interview Google Doc (on SWC website in late September). The PG Interview Google Doc provides students with an opportunity to ensure that their secondary school courses match their post-secondary plans. Students should complete this document after they have:

- -attended university/college fairs
- -visited campuses
- -explored program similarities and differences
- -conferred with Parents/Guardians to come up with a viable post-secondary plan
- -are ready to apply to post-secondary programs

Every Potential Grad meets with a Guidance Counsellor in the fall to ensure that secondary school courses and achievements, and post-secondary plans, are in alignment. University PINs are distributed to students at the meeting.
