**Students in the Justice, Community Safety and Emergency Services Specialist High Skills Major program will:**

- Graduate with a SHSM seal of designation on their Ontario Secondary School Diploma
- Gain valuable industry specific work experience and knowledge in emergency management, the Canadian legal system, psychology and its importance in human relationships, among others
- Develop transferable skills such as leadership, project management, anti-oppression/allyship, and other relevant skills
- Participate in opportunities to explore authentic post secondary education in their chosen pathways
- Network with industry professionals in legal/community safety services, corrections, fire service, law enforcement, paramedic medical services and others

**Achievements in the Program:**

- **Certifications and Awareness Training:** Students will complete selected sector recognized certifications related to their major
- **Experiential Learning Opportunities:** Students will have the opportunity to job shadow industry professionals, get work experience through cooperative education, see guest speakers, go on field trips to explore careers in Justice, Community Safety and Emergency Services

- **Sector Partnered Experience:** The SPE component includes Innovation Creativity and Entrepreneurship (ICE) training where students will work with a sector partner for the day. This opportunity has an experiential and an assessment component.
- **Reach Ahead Experience:** Students will explore post secondary education opportunities in Justice, Community Safety and Emergency Services
- **Pathways into College, University, the Workforce:** Completing the SHSM program prepares students for their pathway to college, university and the workforce (see the pathways below).
